Craig/ Pogue asked about Resolution 22-1-20. He wanted to know if the unanticipated services were litigation and/or contract matters. Rick Dovey explained that were extended negotiations in the EPA & NJDEP matter. There were also extensive OPRA requests and the material we submitted had to be reviewed by counsel before releasing. Mr. Pogue also submitted an OPRA request relating to the proposed Pleasantville transfer station.

Larry Watts also asked about Resolution 22-1-20. He asked if our agreement with Vineland was also a one of the issues addressed. Mr. Dovey said that yes, it was a contributing factor. He also repeated his concerns about the residual material being recycled and the quantity shipped to Pennsylvania. In his opinion we are releasing false data to the public. He expressed his concerns at the Atlantic County Commissioners meeting this week. As a result, Commissioner Bertino emailed Rick Dovey asking him to address Mr. Watts' questions about the recycling issue.

Mr. Watts said that our pay scale is not competitive. Mr. Dovey said that he doesn't agree that we aren't competitive in salary. The ACUA has raised starting salaries twice for drivers and laborers since the beginning of the pandemic, and there are many factors that limit the Authority's ability to increase salaries.
