Explanation: Purchase of rotating assembly for Broadway Pump Station. Amount is

\$48,260.00.

Resolution 19-2-41: Authorizing award of contract to Applied Technical Industries for Procurement of Wastewater Systems maintenance parts and repairs through the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance (U.S. Communities).

Resolution 19-2-45: Rescinding ACUA Resolution 18-12-272 and authorizing a Shared Services Agreement with the City of Ventnor for Solid Waste, Bulky Waste, Yard Waste and Recycling Collection Services. The total annual revenue to the Authority will be \$663,324.57 which includes \$78,859.57 per year for the trash and recycling carts.

Explanation: Amending draft agreement to include Ventnor's cost for the carts.

Resolution 19-2-46: Authorizing award of contract to Cascade Engineering through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing System for the Purchase of Recycling and Trash Carts. Amount is not to exceed \$552,016.90.

Explanation: Purchasing carts in conjunction with the Ventnor City collections contract.

Resolution 19-2-48: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Dun-Rite Sand & Gravel Co., Inc., Bid 2018-SW-04, to Supply, Haul and Furnish Earth Cover Material. Amount of increase is \$721.97.

Explanation: To close out the contract.

Resolution 19-2-49: Authorizing a contract amendment to Professional Services contract with Marks Environmental, Inc. for PPL Quarterly Groundwater & Stormwater Sampling. Amount of increase is \$480.00.

Explanation: To close out the 2018 contract.

Resolution 19-2-50: Authorizing a contract amendment to Professional Services contract with Marks Environmental, Inc. for ACUA Landfill Semi-Annual Groundwater Sampling. Amount of increase is \$2,256.00.

Explanation: Extending contract term to 3/31/19.

Resolution 19-2-51: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Wastequip Manufacturing for Purchase of Metal Rear Load Dumpsters through Sourcewell (formerly NJPA). Amount of increase is \$168.00.

Explanation: Beginning March 1, 2019 the ACUA will provide solid waste collection services to The Cloisters for annual cost of \$4,155.68, and to Ocean 34 Condominiums for annual cost of \$419.77.

Resolution 19-2-53: Authorizing agreement between the ACUA Wastewater Division and the ACUA Solid Waste Division. Annual revenue to the SW Division.is approximately \$195,000.

Explanation: The ACUA Solid Waste Division will continue to provide roll off services for the hauling of sludge material.

Resolution 19-2-54: Rescinding ACUA Resolution 18-12-273 Which Authorized a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Atlantic for Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Services.

Explanation: The County has indicated that our proposal is cost prohibitive.

Resolution 19-2-55: Enabling resolution authorizing the filing of a Spending Plan for a 2018 Recycling Enhancement Act Tax Fund Entitlement pursuant to P.L.2007 c.311 et seq. Explanation: Amount of the grant is \$214,980.00.
