Solid Waste/Recycling – Mr. Akers reported recycling markets improved slightly in May. Solid waste for the month of May was up from 2022. Overall recycling tonnages was down for May due to a large decrease in landfill amendment and clean wood. Year-to-date Solid Waste was up in May from 2022 and overall recycling tonnages was also up from 2022. The ACUA Clean Communities Program had a very productive May.
