BOARD COMMENT: Fred Akers attended the Great Egg Harbor River Council meeting last night with representatives from 12 towns attending. One of the municipal representatives reported about the proactive outreach that the ACUA is doing to educate the public regarding the upcoming plastic bag ban and how to understand and prepare for that. There was also mention of the return of the ACUA Earth Day celebration event this year, and the other numerous public service announcements and environmental products and services offered by the ACUA on its website.

Resolution 22-2-26: Electing Chair of the Atlantic County Utilities Authority.

Resolution 22-2-28: Appointing Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer of the Atlantic County Utilities Authority.

Andrew Berenato appointed as Treasurer; Laura Pfrommer appointed as Assistant Treasurer.

Resolution 22-2-42: Authorizing award of Alternate Method Contracts for Marketing Recyclables.

Explanation: Alternate method contracts for potential marketing recyclables by a blanket agreement for all potential recycling marketing contracts in conjunction with Pay-to-Play compliance.

Brian Lefke said that the market is for scrap metal pulled from the Transfer Station and the Landfill.

Resolution 22-2-49: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Jesco, Inc. for Heavy Equipment Rental, Bid 2020-SW-04. Amount of increase is \$46,552.00.

Explanation: Extending contract time to February 28, 2022. Higher than anticipated rental of heavy equipment by Solid Waste Operations. Amendment amount exceeds 20%.

The State mandates that special procedures be followed when change orders exceed the original contract award by 20%. The purpose of these procedures is to allow for such a change only in limited instances. Such a change is not permitted when the circumstances make it reasonably possible to execute a new contract for the additional work. Such a change may be allowed when an unforeseen circumstance or differing site condition is combined with a situation which renders execution of a new contract an unreasonable interference with the efficient completion of the work.

A list of change orders exceeding 20% is submitted to the DCA with the annual budget.

Resolution 22-2-54: Authorizing a Shared Services Agreement between the Atlantic County Utilities Authority and Stockton University for an Internship Program.

Explanation: This is a three-year program associated with the School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics.

The interns will be involved with the Wildlife Bird Management Program
