WASTEWATER (Mr. Berenato, Chair):

Resolution 20-7-161: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Carbon Activated Corp., Bid 2018-WW-03 for Supply & Disposal of Activated Carbon. Amount of decrease is \$10,000.00.

Explanation: Decreasing the 2020 contract values.

Resolution 20-7-162: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Grainger Parts Operations, Inc. under State Contract for Industrial/MRO Supplies & Equipment. Amount of increase is \$13,000.00.

Explanation: Revising language to clarify the intent of the award.

Resolution 20-7-190: Authorizing Payment to Treasurer of the State of New Jersey for NJPDES Permit Fee, NJEMS ID#207575900 in the amount of \$121,632.36.

Explanation: NJPDES Fee for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

SOLID WASTE (Mr. Akers, Chair):

Resolution 20-7-166: Authorizing the award of a contract in Bid No. 2020-SW-03 for Landfill Gas Piping Supplies to Sandale Utility Products. Amount is not to exceed \$200,000.00 for 24-month contract term.

Explanation: The Proposal amount represents the Total Lump Sum Cost for the purpose of evaluation of the lowest responsible bidder. (ACUA Cooperative Purchasing System)

Explanation: The Authority will perform Solid Waste Collection services for a five-year term October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2025. Revenue to the Authority over the initial five-year term is \$835,097.00.
