NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Dovey advised the Board that as a result of the sale of Egg Harbor City's Water Company to New Jersey American Water, the Joinder Agreement Supplementing Sewage Conveyance and Treatment Agreement will need to be amended in the fall. The amendment will allow American Water to be a participant. The Authority is planning to hold an information session during a closed session at the July 15 Board Meeting. OLD BUSINESS: Tom Ganard briefed the Board on the status of two ongoing Capital projects.

Directional Drill in Atlantic City- Began drilling last Friday and it should take a week to 10 days.

MSE Wall – This project is going really well so much so that the contractor offered to speed the project up and possibly would be 3 months ahead of schedule which would be to the ACUA's benefit. The contractor has offered us the use of the recycled asphalt. He said the project is pretty impressive.

Resolution 21-6-135: Authorizing award of an Alternate Method contract to Associated Wastewater Service, LLC for Wastewater Operations Consulting Services Amount is not to exceed \$53,760.00 for the contract term July 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.

Resolution 21-6-143: Authorizing an Agreement with AtlantiCare Medical Center-Mainland Division for Recycling Roll-Off Collection Services. Estimated revenue to the Authority is \$6,100.00 per year.
