WASTEWATER (Mr. Berenato, Chair):

Resolution 21-10-213: Authorizing the award of an alternate method contract to Chavond-Barry Engineering for consulting services. Amount of contract is not to exceed \$200,000.00 for the contract term January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

Explanation: This contract is for routine consulting services related to Title V Permitting for the Authority's Bio Solids Multiple Hearth Incinerator and its associated Air Emission Equipment.

Resolution 21-10-214: Authorizing the award of a contract in Bid No. 2021-WW-07 for Supply of Sodium Hypochlorite to Kuehne Chemical Company, Option B. Amount is \$659,245.00 for first year, and \$705,000.00 for second year.

Explanation: Total not-to-exceed amount is \$1,364,245.00 for two years.

Resolution 21-10-215: Authorizing the award of a contract in Bid No. 2021-WW-08 for Supply of Ferric Chloride to Kemira Water Solutions, Inc., Option C: Amount is \$117,600.00 for first year, and \$122,500.00 for optional second year.

Explanation: Potential not-to-exceed amount for two years is \$240,150.00.

Resolution 21-10-220: Authorizing the award of a contract to Municipal Maintenance Co. for Procurement of Replacement Pumps, Motors, and Ancillary Parts through The North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Purchasing System. Amount is \$43,750.00.

Explanation: To purchase Chicago 8615 Rotating Assembly.

Resolution 21-10-221: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Kemira Water Solutions for Supply of Ferric Chloride, Bid 2019-WW-10. Amount of decrease is \$160,517.17. Explanation: To reduce contract quantities to reflect close out of 2021 activity.

Resolution 21-10-222: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Nichem, Inc. for Supply & Disposal of Activated Carbon, Bid 2020-WW-06. Amount of increase is \$18,000.00.

Explanation: To increase contract quantities to reflect usages associated with year-end projections for the plant and pumping stations.

Resolution 21-10-223: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Polydyne Corp. for Supply of Polymer Flocculants, Bid 2019-WW-09. Amount of decrease is \$90,000.00. Explanation: To reduce contract quantities to reflect actual usage in 2021.

SOLID WASTE (Mr. Akers, Chair):

Resolution 21-10-224: Authorizing the Rejection of Bid submitted in Bid No. 2021-SW-06 for Supply, Haul & Delivery of Earth Cover Material.

Explanation: Only bid submitted is nonconforming to the Specifications.

Resolution 21-10-225: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Cascade Engineering for 64-Gallon Wheeled Carts through the Sourcewell Purchasing Alliance. Amount of increase is \$5,828,55.

Explanation: For additional cost incurred in conjunction with Absecon contract.

Resolution 21-10-226: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Dun-Rite Sand & Gravel Co., Inc. for Supply, Haul & Furnish Earth Cover Material, Bid 2020-SW-06. Amount of increase is \$171,000.00.

Explanation: Extending contract term to January 31, 2022.

Resolution 21-10-227: Authorizing a Rider to the Shared Services Agreement with the City of Absecon for Solid Waste Collection Services. Cost of additional carts is \$5,828.55.

Explanation: The City requested an additional 130 64-gallon recycling carts at a cost of \$5,828.55 The final cost to the City, before applying any grant funds, is \$191,921.55.
