# RESOLUTION COMMENTS:

Resolution 22-4-95: Authorizing the award of a contract in Bid No. 2022-WW-01 for Lease of Real Property at 1701 Absecon Boulevard, Atlantic City, NJ to Comcast Business Communications, LLC. Initial Annual Base Rent is \$77,100.00. This is a 5-year lease.

Explanation: Awarded to lowest responsible bidder.

It should be noted that this was awarded to the HIGHEST (and the only) bidder.

Resolution 22-4-98: Authorizing a Shared Services Agreement between the Atlantic County Utilities Authority and the Carney's Point Township Sewerage Authority for disposal of sludge for the contract term June 1, 2022 through December 31, 2026.

Explanation: Estimated revenue to the Authority for the first year is \$500,000.00.

The estimated revenue is based on historical values over the past 6 or 7 years.

Resolution 22-4-102: Authorizing the award of a contract to Cascade Engineering Co. for purchase of 96-gallon and 64-gallon trash carts through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing System. Cost is \$187,758.10.

Explanation: In conjunction with City of Absecon collections agreement.

We purchased 2,800 96-gallon carts and 130 64-gallon carts.

Resolution 22-4-106: Authorizing an addendum to contract with AC Landfill Energy LLC for Lease, Operating, Management and Power Purchase Agreement.

Explanation: Transitioning the landfill gas-to-energy project from electricity generation to

renewable natural gas (RNG) generation. This is a culmination of approximately 6 years of work to amend the agreement with South Jersey Industries to switch to renewable natural gas generation. This will be a positive economic impact on the ACUA. We will see a significant increase in revenue and a decrease in expenses in the amount of \$1.5 -\$2 million per year. We are coordinating with SJ Industries on a public relations outreach campaign over the next month.

Kathleen Spaeth thanked Mr. Dovey for his excellent explanation and said that this is a wonderful project.

Resolution 22-4-112: Authorizing a Shared Services Agreement with the Town of Hammonton for Street Sweeping Services for the initial term from May 1, 2022 to April 30, 2023. The ACUA will provide street sweeping services to the Town of Hammonton at the rate of \$207.19 per pull plus the tip fee of \$22.00 per ton. Hammonton will pay regular labor rate of \$97.58 per hour and overtime rate of \$134.95 per hour.

We have similar street sweeping agreements with Linwood and Northfield. These are year-round agreements. A "pull' is a collection event – bringing the material back to the ACUA.

Our legal counsel made some minor adjustments to the agreement.

Resolution 22-4-114: Authorizing extension of land lease agreement between the Atlantic County Utilities Authority and Townsquare Media (previously Millennium). Explanation: Renewal of lease beginning May 1, 2022, for radio tower located at 1801 Absecon Boulevard.

The motion is amended to extend the lease agreement for an additional 30 days in order for review by legal counsel.
